- This course can be either hydraulic/mechanic or electric focused

Who Should Attend?

Personnel who will maintain the equipment or personnel designated to oversee maintenance of the equipment should attend this course.

Prerequisites

Before participating in this course, each student should have basic product knowledge as well as hydraulic or electric knowledge, depending on the student's discipline.

Goals and Objectives

Hands-on training is intended for installations in operation. A skilled instructor or service engineer visits the rig and spends time with maintenance personnel during operation.

Typically, hands-on training contains no theoretical training, but provides maintenance personnel with useful information regarding safe and effective operation and maintenance procedures.
